

## **NACT UK POSITION STATEMENT**

### **ADOPTING MULTIPLE EDUCATIONAL ROLES**

A discussion took place at the 2008 AGM and guidance sought from NACT UK on how the time required for an educational role was identified and remunerated and whether an individual could have multiple educational roles both locally and at regional or national level.

**The statement below has been approved by NACT UK Council to assist members in their local negotiations.**

- Professionalising medical education requires that those taking on educational roles, whatever they may be, should ensure that realistic time and resource is explicitly provided in their formal job plan to enable them to do a high quality job.
- NACT UK Members should consider carefully and declare any potential conflict of interest if they accept a Deanery/University/College based educational role in addition to their local role.
- Although NACT UK can offer guidance it is acknowledged that this is a local issue for the member and the employer to discuss & settle through the job planning process.
