

NACT UK POSITION STATEMENT

REMUNERATION FOR THE DIRECTOR OF MEDICAL EDUCATION

The role of the Director of Medical Education is an important role within the Trust and dedicated time within the job plan is required to cover all aspects of the job description (see NACT UK Guide 2007) to a high standard.

The statement below has been approved by NACT UK Council to assist members in their local negotiations.

- The NACT UK Guide August 2007 suggest 3-5PAs will be required for the role.
- **For the PGME component**, a minimum of 2 PAs are required. In larger Trusts more PAs will be needed. This assumes that there is a Tutor & administrative structure beneath the DME doing the operational running of the Foundation Programme and Education Centres.
- If the role of the Director also includes overseeing the Foundation Programme, Undergraduate, SAS and/or Multi-professional education additional time would be required.
